General Information

Rehearsals are held on Sunday afternoons, beginning February 24th, from 2 pm to 5 pm at Saginaw Valley State University. Each Sunday the students will be part of sectional rehearsals and full orchestra rehearsals. A break will be given about half-way through the afternoon.

Requirements

Musicians are **expected** to participate in their school instrumental music programs (if available) and are strongly recommended to take private music instruction. The Saginaw Bay Youth Orchestra also welcomes home-schooled musicians.

Each student should be able to sight-read a short orchestral excerpt in addition to the following:

Strings

Scales: 2 or 3 octaves up to 3 sharps and 3 flats

Prepared Solo: Student's choice (2 minutes) at Suzuki Book 3 or higher

Winds

Scales: 2 octaves up to 3 sharps and 3 flats

Prepared Solo: Student's choice (2 minutes)

Percussion

Prepared Solo: Excerpts for snare, mallet, and timpani (1 minute each)

Piano

Scales: 2 octaves up to 3 sharps and 3 flats, hands together

Prepared Solo: Student's choice (e.g. Bach's 2-part invention)
