Send the following 4 items:

1. **No more than 7-minute sample of your playing on CD, cassette or MP3 format. THIS MUST CONTAIN NO PERSONAL IDENTIFYING MARKING OF ANY KIND. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. A completed Entry Form
3. Proof of age (copy of birth certificate, driver's license)
4. Proof of residency (copy of driver's license)
  - No responsibility is accepted for entries delayed in the post, received late or insufficiently stamped.
  - Items will not be returned.
  - Competitors should ensure that their entry form is correctly and clearly filled in.
  - Receipt of a completed entry form implies acceptance of the rules. The organizers reserve the right to legislate on any point arising which is not provided for in these rules.

### Rules and Conditions

- Competitors must be 18 years or younger by March 3, 2008.
- Competitors must reside in one of the following counties: Bay, Clinton, Genesee, Huron, Midland, Saginaw, Sanilac, Shiawassee and Tuscola.
- Any musician who has performed with the Saginaw Bay Symphony Orchestra is not eligible.
- Any musician who is employed by Citizens Bank or is a family member of an employee of Citizens Bank or any of its affiliates is not eligible.
- Any instrument, any style—not necessarily symphonic.
- Sound quality must be reasonable enough to clearly hear the candidate.
- Your demo can be with or without keyboard accompaniment or with or without other musicians.
- Your recording will be given a code number by the Project Coordinator.
- Your Application Form, plus the code number, will be locked in a safe until the winning number is chosen.
- The Project Coordinator will forward your recording to the Musicians' Committee for anonymous evaluation.
- Once the Musicians' Committee has made a selection, the Project Coordinator will match code with personal details and the winner's name will be announced.

### Judges

- The decision of the judges is final and no further correspondence or discussion will be entered in to.
- Date of Decision: April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008
- Judges will consist of Saginaw Bay Symphony Orchestra personnel – no teacher or parent having an entry in the competition may act as a judge. Honorary judges will be Jim VanTifflin and Stacey Gannon of Citizens Bank Wealth Management.
